

CRSB Auditor Requirements

Character and competency attributes

- Non-biased
- Professional, ethical, open-minded, diplomatic, observant, adaptable, organized, collaborative, impartial (From ISO 19011)
- Evidence of ongoing training or continuing education
- Proof of auditing competency (e.g. ISO auditor training, Canadian Food Inspection Agency-approved auditor program, Professional Animal Auditor Certification Organization training, other industry audit-related training)

Education and skills consisting of:

- Education – certificate, training college or university degree in agriculture with 5 years of related field/ industry experience, or 10+ years of industry experience
- Ability to succinctly summarize observation and interview results
- In-depth knowledge of the beef industry
- Possess the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve the intended results of the audits they are expected to perform (From ISO 19011)
- Possess generic knowledge, skills and some discipline and sector-specific knowledge and skills to conduct the audit (From ISO 19011)
- Ability to understand industry sector language and communicate effectively with clients
- Ability to keep information confidential
